



Field e Fex, LLC, a New York limited liability company, (“We”, “Our” and “Us”), is committed to protecting the privacy and security of the data of Our customers and users of the Field e Fex Software™ (the “Service”). We want you to understand how We collect and use information from the Service so you can interact with Us with confidence. By using the Service, you accept and agree to the practices this Privacy Policy describes.

Information We Collect

When you use the Service, We may collect and use personally identifiable information about you, as well as other information relating to others that the Service is designed to track. “Personally identifiable information” includes the name, address, email address, payment information and other similar information that can be used to identify an individual. More specifically, when you use the Service, We may collect the following information:

- Details of your visits to the Services and the resources that you access, including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, Weblogs and other communication data, including your IP address, browser type, the date and time you accessed or left the Service, and which pages you viewed. Some parts of the Service use cookies and other technologies to collect this information about your general internet Usage. See the section below called “*How We use Cookies*” to learn more.

How We Use Cookies

Cookies may store user preferences and other information. You can reset your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. Keep in mind, however, that some Service features may not function properly without cookies. While We use cookies, We do not track Our users once they have left the Service.

“Do Not Track” Requests

The Service is not designed to respond to “do not track” or similar signals.

Use of Your Information

We use the information We collect from you primarily to enable Us to provide the Service to you in the best possible manner. Security

- comply with applicable laws, regulations, legal process (such as a subpoena), or enforceable government request;

- protect against harm to Our rights, property, or safety, Our users, or the public as required or permitted by law.
